The Bachelor of Liberal Arts (BLA) Program allows students to create a multidisciplinary Plan of Study, which must include all remaining requirements to complete the degree. It is important to work closely with a BLA advisor to review your application requirements, along with the remaining degree requirements.

## Minimum graduation requirements include:

- A minimum of 128 hours with a 2.0 GPA or higher
- 51 hours of upper division coursework (numbered 300-499)
- 37 hours of the Core Curriculum with a $C$ or higher in each course
- 21 hours of BLA residency
- Exit Essay
